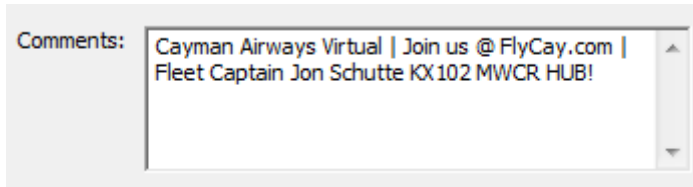


Event Guidelines

We ask that you do the following when participating with us in any of our online events;

Include the following in your Vatsim flightplan remarks:

- You must use your Cayman Airways Virtual assigned callsign when flying online during events. This information is available through our Roster page, as well as your current rank!

- We ask that you please respect ALL ATC when flying online, avoid confrontation. We are a professional operation and hold all pilots to the highest of standards. Should we see behavior that we deem unacceptable you will be dealt with appropriately by a member of staff.

- Join Teamspeak at least 15 minutes prior to the event, if possible. This will allow us to better coordinate stand numbers for departure gates, discuss any last minute changes in routings, flight levels, departure procedures, ATC expectations etc.

- You must have sufficient knowledge of the aircraft that you'll be operating during the event! Vatsim controllers expect you to be able to fly an ILS approach, a heading, climb and descend to specified altitudes, enter holding patterns over a designated FIX! If you are unable to do any of these things, we recommend that you do some reading before jumping in to Vatsim.

- Carefully review the weather conditions and flight conditions in correspondence to the current and possibly changing weather.

These are just a set of basic pre-flight preparations that must be done before the flight to increase the efficiency of the flight, so please set aside a sufficient amount of time to do so. Don't forget to have some fun! Virtual Airlines although simulating the real world operations of an airline are a place for fun and relaxation, don't get stressed out over the small stuff!
